References

References are required only for New Staff applications (have not worked at Ryerson on Perm Staff in the past). You are required to have 3 references. Two will fill out reference forms and submit them to the camp (see above for address). Your third reference should be willing to speak to one of us over the phone after your interview. Please ensure that one reference is able to speak to your spiritual life and one to your ability to work with children. Please do not use Ryerson Perm or Volunteer Staff as References (Current Director/Asst Directors or Current Youth Camp Directing Team).

Interviews

Returning Staff will be contacted by a member of the Directing Team to set up an informal conversation (in person or over the phone) about the possibility of returning to camp for another season. First Time Applicants will be contacted to set up an in person interview which will take place in Milton, Ontario on Saturday, March 3, 2011. If you know that you are unavailable on that date please let us know in your application.

Due to high volume of application we cannot offer interviews to everyone.

Police Checks

A Police Records Check with Vulnerable Persons Screening is required for all staff who work at Ryerson Camp. First year staff members are required to submit a new check (2012). Returning Staff who have a PRC on file with Ryerson Camp that is less than 3 years old may use this in lieu of a new PRC.

Program Dates

The necessary dates for which full summer staff need to be available are from June 22nd to August 28th. That includes training week and all camp weeks (2012 schedule is available at www.ryersoncamp.com). Exact training dates will be finalised by the beginning of the interview process.

If it is not possible for you to be at camp for the whole summer that is ok, please consider some other options. Volunteers are a vital part of Ryerson camp so please call us about coming for a week or so. We also highly recommend the Leadership Development Camp for those 16 and over who are looking for leadership training opportunities (please get in touch with us if you have any questions).

Roles at Camp

At Ryerson Camp we are most interested in hiring individuals who want to be at camp and with kids, regardless of the position they hold but we are interested to hear your thoughts on where you might best fit at Camp and where you are most excited to serve. Please ensure that you have read the Job Descriptions before applying - many positions require specialised experience or training - keep this in mind.
