

RYERSON WILDERNESS CAMPS

Ryerson's Wilderness program offers specialty camps designed for the adventurous camper who enjoys the outdoors. The camp is open to 20 campers per session and is run primarily on Ryerson's Wilderness site. The small group setting and low camper to staff ratio allow for excellent group bonding and interaction.

Campers and staff sleep in tents (provided by the camp) and cook most meals over an open fire. Campers will get to be involved in meal preparation and cleanup.

Activities include but are not limited to: hiking, low-ropes course, wilderness skill building, crafts, campfires, games, daily swimming, archery and more. Gopher, Junior, and Intermediate campers also enjoy a canoeing day-trip!
