RYERSON FACILITIES

Potable Water

Potable water is located at a number of convenient locations throughout the camp.

Washroom Facilities

There are both flush and vault facilities located within the camp. Flush toilets and washing sinks are located at 3 main spots on site. Vault toilets with hand washing are available within the cabent and car camping areas. At this time due to Covid protocols public showers are closed.

Camp Store

A small camp store is located at the camp director's office. Basic camper's supplies (matches, fire starters, basic first aid supplies), souvenirs (clothing, mugs, hats), mattresses and firewood are available. This will be open for limited hours each day.

Beach Volleyball Court

Located within the main activity field is a beach volleyball court. Volleyballs can be signed out from the camp office.

Outdoor Basketball Court

An outdoor basketball court is located near the main hall. Basketballs can be signed out from the camp office.
