Overview

The lifeguard/program staff of Ryerson Camp will serve a special role on our staff team. Not only will they perform all the duties of a lifeguard, ensuring the waterfront safety of our campers and staff, but they will also play a vital role in the development and execution of all camp programming.

Responsibilities

- Act as a lifeguard during all waterfront activities, under the direction of the Head Lifeguard.
- Maintain a confident knowledge of OCA waterfront safety regulations.
- Care for the safety and sanitary conditions of the camp's waterfront with the lifeguard team.
- Work with the Program Coordinator to plan and execute daily programming.
- Accountability to camp directors.
- Other program duties as assigned by the camp directors.

- NLS/Bronze Cross certification (*must be completed before arrival to staff training*)
- First Aid/CPR.
- Ability to stay calm in stressful situations.
- Able to handle a physically strenuous job.
- Highly creative and enthusiastic about developing fun and engaging activities for children.
- Interpersonal skills and ability to work well in a team environment.
- Organized with great time management skills.
